

ALCONA TOWNSHIP BOARD MINUTES  
July 13, 2010

The Alcona Township regular board meeting was called to order with a pledge to the flag at 7:00 p.m. at the township hall.

Roll call was taken. Present: Supervisor Roger Carlin, Clerk Dawn LaLonde, Treasurer Tina Gauthier, Trustees Marlana MacNeill and Jim Mead.

The clerk's minutes of the previous meeting were approved and filed.

The Treasurer's report was approved and filed.

Motion by Mead, seconded by MacNeill, to pay bills as presented. PASSED

Ted Somers introduced himself as a candidate for the Alcona County Road Commission and asked for support on the August 3<sup>rd</sup> election.

Supervisor Carlin will have some gravel hauled into the Black River Ball Park road to fill some deep holes.

The permit for dredging Black River will expire in 2011. Supervisor Carlin has done all of the drawings and paperwork to apply for a 5 year permit. A check will be made out to the State of Michigan in the amount of \$50.00 to complete the process.

It was decided not to replace the tables and chairs at the township hall at this time as the hall is seldom rented.

Motion by Mead, seconded by Gauthier, to pay an additional \$44.20 to LaFave Excavating for the work done on Ridge Road. PASSED The additional cost was do to them replacing a culvert with a larger size then first quoted.

Motion by LaLonde, seconded by Gauthier, to pass a resolution allowing Scott Park Subdivision, Scott Subdivision and adjacent properties to create a special assessment district.

Roll Call vote: Gauthier-Yes LaLonde-Yes Carlin-Yes MacNeill-Yes Mead-Yes

Treasurer Gauthier has certified that over 51% of the property owners have requested this. (Copy of Resolution attached) A special hearing concerning this special assessment will be held on Tuesday, August 3, 2010 at noon at the Alcona Township Hall.

Motion by Gauthier, seconded by LaLonde to pay 100% of one pass of dust control on Woodland Drive. PASSED Clerk LaLonde will contact C & S Carriers.

Will Brege, Zoning Administrator, is working on a nuisance and health hazard on Fontaine Road. The property owner did sign for a letter sent to him on the subject of the nuisance. Mr. Brege will follow up with a phone call.

Supervisor Carlin will finalize the plans for the front porch and advertise for bids.

Complete Fire Report on File

Supervisor Carlin received a phone call concerning drainage problems after a rain near the East Bay Access Site. He will look into this.

Motion by Gauthier, seconded by Carlin to accept the following people as election inspectors once they complete their training, Lynn Gibson, Norma Ludwiczak, Harriet Gauthier, Loraine Gauthier, Annette Kane, Sherry Bowers and Larry Bowers. PASSED
